Typical Kitten Vaccination Schedule

6-10 Weeks Physical Exam
Leukemia and FIV Test
FVRCCP Vaccine
Bordetella
Strategic Deworming
Intestinal Parasite Screening
HomeAgain Microchip with 1 Year Membership
1 Complimentary Dose of Parasite Prevention

10-14 Weeks Physical Exam
FVRCCP Vaccine
Rabies Vaccination at 12 weeks
Strategic Deworming
Intestinal Parasite Screening
12 months of Parasite Prevention

14-18 Weeks Physical Exam
FVRCCP Vaccine
Rabies (if still needed)
Leukemia Vaccine #1
Strategic Deworming
Intestinal Parasite Screening

18-22 Weeks Leukemia Vaccine #2

6-12 Months Pre-Surgery ECG
Pre-surgery Bloodwork Panel
Spay or Neuter with Laser Upgrade and Take Home Pain Medications and Elizabethan Collar

Preventative Care

- Pretreatment with vaccines if needed
- Leukemia and FIV testing

- HomeAgain Microchip and 1 year membership
- 12 months of parasite prevention
- Spay or Neuter:
Surgical laser upgrade, I.V. catheter and fluids, electronic and nurse monitoring during anesthesia, endotracheal tube for airway protection, pain injections and oral take home pain medications, an optional 1 night stay in the hospital, elizabethan collar to prevent surgical site licking and chewing, suture removal in 2 weeks, pre-surgery bloodscreening, pre-surgery ECG.

Early Detection

- 3 Intestinal parasite screenings and appropriate intestinal parasite treatments
- 1 Complimentary Illness Exam if needed
- Pre-surgery bloodwork panel prior to spay or neuter surgery
- ECG prior to spay or neuter surgery
